The **Julie Rogers "Gift of Life" Program** is a special cooperative effort of Memorial Hermann Baptist Hospitals, the Julie & Ben Rogers Cancer Institute, the University of Texas Medical Branch (UTMB) at Galveston and its local clinics, the UTMB Cancer Stop Program, local physicians, and The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center.

Since its inception the "Gift of Life" has provided more than 8,000 free mammograms and 2,800 free prostate cancer screenings for individuals in Southeast Texas with UTMB-Galveston available for follow-up medical care. In addition, the program has conducted over 225 Sidney "Chief" Dauphin educational outreach programs that stress the importance of early detection.

The mission of the **Jefferson County Medical Society** is to serve as an advocate for its physician members in providing ethical, quality, cost-effective medical care for all Southeast Texans.

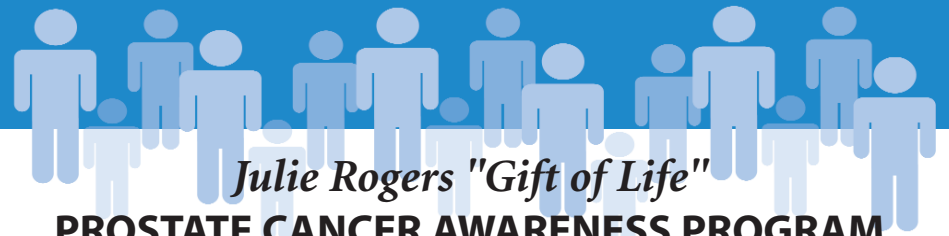

## CONFERENCE LECTURERS

### Curtis A. Pettaway, MD

Curtis A. Pettaway, MD, is an Associate Professor of Urology in the Department of Urology at The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center. His areas of interest include patients with prostate, penile and bladder cancers. Dr. Pettaway also focuses on combination treatment strategies for high-risk prostate cancer, racial disparities in prostate cancer, and intraoperative lymphatic mapping and new treatments for penile cancer. He serves as Medical Director of the MD Anderson Cancer Center Prostate Outreach Project. Co-sponsored by the Cancer Center, this federally-funded project promotes prostate cancer education and early detection in underserved communities. Further, Dr. Pettaway leads a NIH-funded national consortium of African-American Investigators identifying families with prostate cancer, with the goal of identifying candidate genes associated with the disease via genetic linkage studies.

### Jane Williams, MSN, APRN, BC, FNP

Jane Williams, MSN, APRN, BC, FNP, is an Advanced Practice Nurse and Nurse Practitioner in the Department of Genitourinary Medical Oncology at The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center. Ms. Williams has practiced over 25 years in oncology nursing, 9 years as a nurse practitioner and has spent the last several years in Genitourinary Medical Oncology.

### Elizabeth Hossan, RN, MS, CFNP

Elizabeth Hossan, RN, MS, CFNP, is an Advanced Practice Nurse and Nurse Practitioner in the Department of Genitourinary Medical Oncology at The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center. Ms. Hossan's background includes more than 20 years of experience in oncology nursing, 19 years of which have been spent in Genitourinary Medical Oncology.

Both Ms. Williams' and Ms. Hossan's professional backgrounds include prostate cancer screening, contact with prostate cancer patients in active treatment, managing symptoms related to cancer and cancer therapy, and long-term follow-up after therapy. Ms. Williams and Ms. Hossan have each taught and lectured extensively on the topic of prostate cancer to both professional and public audiences, and have also published on the subject.
